# A Good Campfire and A Good Faith


Summer in Wisconsin offers so many blessings! For instance, there is nothing like a good summer campfire. We can sit around it, sing songs,

laugh, tell stories, roast all kinds of great food like hots dogs, marshmallows, s'mores, mountain ("pudgie") pies and I know you can add so much more to the list. Or we can just sit peacefully and watch the shimmering coals, the dancing flames, listening to the crackling of the fire and follow the sparks as they fly up to the glistening stars in the night sky.

A good campfire is like a good Christian Faith. It is warming, soothing, and brings moments of peace and joy. If you want to put out a fire faster, you spread out the coals and pieces of wood from each other. If you want a warmer, more comforting fire, you know that you must tend to the fire and keep the coals and other pieces of wood closer to each other. God in His comforting love calls us throughout the summer to make sure that we are not being spread out and separated from His Holy Word, His Holy Sacraments, and fellow believers in Jesus Christ. God wants us to, no matter how far we travel, to stay close to worshiping with fellow believers and to His comforting and counseling preaching of His Holy Scriptures and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Holy Spirit tell us in Hebrews 10:23-25, "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for He who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

Make sure that you are singing, praying, hearing the Holy Bible, worshiping the Creator of Heaven and Earth, and the One Who carried and died on a tree to set you free from every sin, and who gives you the gift of Forgiveness, and a Heavenly Lght that will never go out. Indeed, we worship the One who provides summer for us.



## More Than a Negative

Even if you've never had to testify in court, a thousand TV shows have made you familiar with the question, "Do you swear to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth?" Why not just make people swear to tell the truth? Or make them promise not to lie?

Any parent who has ever had to interrogate a child about a broken cookie jar or a scuffle over a toy knows the answer. There are plenty of ways to try to get out of trouble without *technically* lying. You tell *just enough* of the truth to skate on by.

We often play the game of seeing *how close* we can get to sinning without *technically* going over the line.

But in our heart of hearts we know that this is not what God intended when He gave us the commandments. He's not giving us a merely negative rule and challenging us to just barely stay away from this or that. There is much more to each commandment than a prohibition. We shouldn't just avoid murdering people — we should be of service to our neighbor.

For each negative prohibition in the commandments there is a positive good that we are to cherish and protect. In the Eighth Commandment, that gift is the reputation of our neighbor and our relationship with him:

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

Your relationship with your family members (who are your nearest neighbors), the other members of your congregation, your coworkers and your friends is one of the most precious gifts you have been given. You need to exercise good stewardship with this gift just as much as you need to exercise good stewardship with your life, resources, time and income. This is


an especially fragile gift because it's easy to ruin a relationship with slander and talking behind someone's back.

But speaking well of your neighbor in Christian love is absolutely free; it costs you nothing, yet it pays you great dividends. If you find this challenging at times, if you are tempted to speak ill of others,



just remember that this other person is also a beloved child of God for whom your Lord Jesus suffered and died. Your Lord Jesus loves you both.




